



Eligibility for Low-Income Transfer Station Permits

The Town of Winchester announces the eligibility requirements to obtain a low-income transfer station permit. Low Income Permits are available for residents who qualify at a cost of (\$30.00) per household. Only one sticker shall be provided. Citizens must provide proof that they are eligible for fuel assistance, through the Tri Community Action Program, Inc. as a qualifying factor.

Residents must submit the following documentation:

- A signed 2008 census form, to prove residency and size of household.

AND

- A copy of “Eligibility Notification” for the 2007-2008 Fuel Assistance Program from Tri-Community Action Program, Inc.

OR

- Income tax returns, bank statements, social security statements, pay check stubs, or any other evidence that shows the **total combined income for all family members.**
