Legal Notice of Public Hearing**

Pursuant the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Winchester Wetlands Bylaw, the Winchester Conservation Commission will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, at 8:15 PM in the Mystic Valley Room, located at the Winchester Town Hall, 71 Mt. Vernon Street, Winchester. A Request for an Amended Order of Conditions has been filed by the Town of Winchester for work to be performed at Lynch School, 10 Brantwood Road, Winchester. It is proposed to install rip rap stream bank protection in the vicinity of the proposed pedestrian bridge to prevent scouring of the bank.

Portions of the proposed work may lie within wetland resource areas, and/or 100' buffer zones, floodplain, or the 200' riverfront area. The application is on file at the Commission office, may be accessed at the Conservation Commission section of the Town of Winchester website, or outside the Conservation office on the lower level of the Winchester Town Hall.
