**Description:**

This award to Town of Winchester is part of MassDOT's FY'23 Shared Streets and Spaces Program. This grant award of \$87480.25 is to construct curb extensions to help manage speeds at the Wildwood Street curve, proximate to the Lynch School.

The Shared Streets and Spaces Program provides technical assistance and project funding to help Massachusetts cities and towns design and implement changes to curbs, streets, and parking areas in support of public health, safe mobility, and community growth and revitalization. This round of funding placed particular emphasis on two new types of projects: those to reduce vehicle speeds in order to increase safety, and those to purchase equipment needed to improve and maintain infrastructure for active transportation.

We received a record number of applications and had many creative projects from which to select. I am pleased to notify you that Winchester's application for "Wildwood Woodside Speed Management" has been approved for \$87,480.25.

Awarded municipalities must enter into a contract with MassDOT for the funding of the approved work. To initiate this contract, please review and sign the Project Funding Agreement provided to you with this award letter and return it to [SharedStreets@dot.state.ma.us](mailto:SharedStreets@dot.state.ma.us) as soon as possible. It is anticipated that the Notice to Proceed (NTP) for this award will be issued by August 1, 2022 and that the deadline for construction will be December 31, 2023. MassDOT-funded work may not proceed until the NTP is issued. Your patience during the contracting process is appreciated as MassDOT works to execute contracts with a large volume of awardees.

This award is reimbursement-based, meaning that funds are provided after costs are incurred. Please note that this is different than previous funding years. Reimbursement requests are processed by your District State Aid Engineer in the same manner as Chapter 90 projects.
