Thank you for taking the time to review this request for approval of Winchester Youth baseball and Softball to gift repairs needed to Ginn Field.

Winchester Youth Baseball and Softball would like to request approval from the Select Board to a Gift between \$17,730.00- \$22,730 to replace the two dugouts that were washed away two years ago as well repair and paint the backstop fence that currently is falling apart and in not repairable according to three individual fence companies. This project will take approx 4 days to complete and upon approval of the board and with the approval of all appropriate departments we hope to have this project completed at the latest Mid March.

The WFD committee has been made aware of the dugout project and has approved the design of the two dugouts at Ginn Field Lights. Each Dugout will be 25 feet long and 10 ft deep surrounded by fencing to allow site lines into the dugout from outside of the field.

The back stop project will include the removal of all chain link fences that are pulling off of the original structure. A vinegar application applied to the galvanized poles along with a coat of black paint to match the fence and the new dugouts. New black fencing will be placed on the back stop and properly secured

to the back stop extending the life of the currently damaged structure.

This project will be completed at Prevailing Wages by Boston Hill Fence LLC out of Haverhill MA (see attached quote).

This project is part of Winchester Youth Baseball and Softball plan to help revitalize Ginn Field's playing fields for all the town to enjoy. Last year Winchester Youth Baseball and Softball invested in the rebuilding of three infields at Ginn for the use of its citizens. Both youth, mens and womens rec league got to enjoy the professionally installed infield at Ginn and the feedback was outstanding. We are looking forward that with your approval of this gift we can continue to improve the fields at Ginn.
