A quorum being in attendance, the hearing was called to order at 7:40.

Demolition Delay Public Hearing 7 & 7A Webster Street

Review of the application to demolish 1 garage and 3 porches on the property located at 7 & 7A Webster Street. Due to the porches only being a partial demolition the Historical Commission has no jurisdiction over the porches. Hearing will only encompass the demolition of the garage.

John Clemson reviewed the history of the property. The dwelling was built circa 1889 – 1896. It originally had a shared carriage house, which was demolished in 1948. The current garage on the property was erected in 1948. The garage does not hold any historical significance.

Motion That the Historical Commission impose a 12 month delay on the demolition of the garage located at 7 & 7A Webster Street, Winchester, MA. The motion was made by Bruce Hickey and seconded. The motion failed unanimously.
