



Ms. Turenne then left the meeting, at which point there ceased to be a quorum of members. The remaining members elected to continue the meeting as an informational session.

5. Ms. Trimarchi reviewed with the group the key proposals that will likely be made in the Climate Action Plan, including asking for a full-time Sustainability Director; encouraging green infrastructure; developing a comprehensive climate action communications policy; electrifying the town vehicle fleet; installing EV charges; incentivizing residents to opt for WINPower 100; electrifying buildings; increasing solar; advocating for state and federal policy changes; subsidizing school buses; exploring the possibility of an intra-town shuttle; considering a tree-preservation bylaw; seeking climate expertise on town committees and in town planning; collaborating in regional efforts; and forming a new Climate Action Plan Implementation group.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, upon motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously
