The Town is in pretty decent shape with a lot of objectives but Ms. Wong wants to make sure that we don't draw down on the reserves.

The biggest concern is the Recreation Department, as it has its own building and will not be bringing in the funds, \$700,000, this year. Ms. Wong questioned what the new Recreation Department will look like with social distancing? Ms. Shapiro suggested that we need to be innovative in our plans for the department such as looking at the rental of the fields in the fall. Ms. Wong stated that the fields are getting a break right now, which is improving their conditions. Staff is in the planning stage of the maintenance of the fields and have been able to get a head start on the repairs.

- 5. Muraco Update** - Pete Lawson, Facilities Manager, informed the Board that they have started working on the bathrooms at the Muraco. Given that all of the schools are closed we can move forward with the repairs that are needed, plus taking care of the HVACs. Ms. Wong also stated that we have to remember that the schools will look much different, such as rugs on the floor, and other items that cannot be easily cleaned will have to be removed.
