



## TRANSPORTATION AND TRAFFIC



As a result of the needs assessment, issues related to transportation and traffic emerged across data collection activities as a top concern for the Winchester community



**71%** of Winchester residents **drove (alone)** to work in 2016



**12%** of Winchester residents relied on **public transportation** to get to work in 2016




### Traffic Congestion

Among survey respondents...

**27%** moderate concern

**36%** high concern



### Availability of Public Transportation

Among survey respondents...

**26%** moderate concern

**19%** high concern

*"Traffic congestion has progressively worsened for several years. I live on Washington St. and it's now a parking lot virtually every morning."*

of survey respondents overall identified **transportation services** as a missing service in Winchester



### Transportation to Activities Other than Work

Among survey respondents aged **65 years and older**...

**28%** moderate concern

**21%** high concern

*"[There isn't] transportation to and from the food pantry so if you're in Winchester and are trying to get to Woburn - there are public buses but then you're lugging back 5 or 6 bags of groceries."*

**45%**

of survey respondents aged 65 years and older identified **transportation services** as a missing service in Winchester



**38%**

of survey respondents identified **pedestrian safety** as a high concern in Winchester



**34%**

of survey respondents identified **bike safety** as a high concern in Winchester

*"There are not enough sidewalks or cross walks! [...] This is a safety issue on this street whenever anyone is walking."*
