VOTING INFORMATION

ABSENTEE BALLOTING – beginning February 3, 2020 you can vote absentee in the Town Clerk’s Office during all regular business hours; Monday 8am-7pm, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8am-4pm as well as Friday 8am-12noon. To qualify for an absentee ballot you must 1) be absentee from the Town all hours of the Election on March 3, 2020 or 2) Physical Disability or 3) Religious tenant preventing you from casing a ballot on March 3, 2020.

You may vote “In Person” starting February 3, 2020 at the Town Clerk’s counter or you may request a ballot be mailed to you by filling out the attached Absentee Ballot Application. Absentee Balloting closes on Monday, March 2, 2020 at 12noon in order for the Town Clerk to prepare the Voter Lists for Election Day.

EARLY VOTING: - beginning Monday, February 24th and running thru Friday, February 28, 2020 the Town Clerk’s Office will be conducting **Early Voting** for during all normal business hours; Monday 8am-7pm, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8am-4pm as well as Friday 8am-12noon. Early Voting is available to any registered voter in the Town of Winchester. Early Voting differs from Absentee Voting simply because you don’t need a reason to vote early. We refer to it as no excuse voting. You can additionally request an Early Voting ballot be mailed to you if you cannot come to the Town Clerk’s Office during the week.
